[NOTE: Both STABLE-2000 and STABLE-2007 significantly predicted sexual recidivism in a sample of 263 Austrian sex offenders. The STABLE -2007 added incrementally to the Static-99 for prediction of violent and general recidivism and was close ( $p=.086$ ) for sexual recidivism. The absolute recidivism rates in the Austrian sample matched those predicted by the Static-STABLE combination found in the DSP study.]

[NOTE: STABLE-2007 showed strong predictive accuracy (AUC of .86) in a sample of 96 forensic patients. Also included a sample of 274 Austrian prisoners that overlaps with Eher et al. (2012). STABLE-2007 was incremental to Static-99 among both groups: forensic patients ( $p=.019$ ) and prisoners ( $p<.001$ ).

Presentation at the annual Research and Treatment Conference of the Association for the Treatment of Sexual Abusers, Denver, CO.* [NOTE: STABLE-2007 incremental to Static-99R for sexual recidivism (p= .037) and serious recidivism (p= .029). Re-coding of files for 168 offenders from the Ontario Regional Treatment Centre, average 23-year follow-up.]
